



# Refurbishment and adaptations

Shepherd's Bush Police Station, Metropolitan Police, London

## Highlights

Axis completed refurbishment works and internal and external adaptations to Shepherd's Bush Police Station, a facility which had been closed for three years to reopen as a 24 hour processing unit.

The works included a full strip out of the station back to its shell and core including removing partition walls, suspended ceilings, flooring and door entry systems ready to renew what had previously been break out rooms and an outdated lobby.

Our client's objective was to repurpose the facility to create a new entrance, front counter, waiting area and interview rooms. Mechanical and Electrical installation followed the strip-out, incorporating electric, data and bespoke lighting designed for the new building configuration.

The main entrance was remodelled by renewing a large canopied entrance for improved accessibility and installation of new automatic doors. Whilst main and disabled counters, DDA compliant, were designed and fitted in the newly created glazed lobby area and interview rooms. The interior fit-out was completed by installing suspended ceilings, new walls, doors and flooring before decorating.

Externally the property was adapted to include new Disabled Parking Bays, paving and access handrails.
