Highlights

Axis was commissioned by the Mayor's Office for Policing and Crime for the external refurbishment and roof renewal project at Great Scotland Yard in Whitehall, Central London. This is the home of their Central London Mounted Division.

In the past six years Axis have successfully delivered various projects on the Met Police Estate to over 64 of their 200+ premises in and around London which include some of their high security covert locations and all in a live operational environment.

The works to this listed heritage building comprised roof renewal works using natural Welsh slates and lead, conservation roof light installation, careful non-abrasive façade cleaning and redecoration with modern-day environmentally-friendly paints.

The stone and masonry repairs along with the removal/repair of the ornate railings were undertaken carefully by our conservation specialists using methods sympathetic and in keeping with to the age and listing of this building with approved reclaimed materials and methods to maintain the historic importance of the building.

We also upgraded the secondary double glazing as the timber sash windows were to be retained as these are protected under the listing of this building.
