



Internal and external refurbishment

Hornsey Custody Cell, Metropolitan Police, London

Highlights

The Metropolitan Police commissioned Axis as the Principal Contractor to complete an internal and external refurbishment project at their Hornsey station and adjoining buildings, to create a larger yard and additional parking.

The de-commissioning project required demolition of four buildings whilst maintaining the structural integrity of the adjoining buildings. The internal strip out included the re-routing of the plumbing, heating, electrical and ventilation systems in order to service the facility.

The purpose built cell block required specialist cutting equipment to remove the metal and timber-clad surface structure to the reinforced walls and cell doors. Further internal works included conversion of a kitchen into locker rooms and demolition of a CID office.

The remaining building was stabilised with new structural foundations and a timber frame. A linked corridor was constructed, followed by the installation of a new roof and lighting.

A new public entrance was constructed incorporating new doors, steps and DDA compliant handrails. Internal finishing works included installation of a suspended ceiling, flooring and redecoration.

External works to the facility included remedial repairs to an unserviceable underground drainage system. Additional groundworks undertaken to the adjoining yard, incorporated resurfacing to the lower and upper car parks, creating additional parking spaces, new parking bays, lighting, cycle shed and confidential waste units.
