



Heritage Refurbishment

The Hurlingham Club, south west London

Highlights

Studio Gunn appointed Axis for a heritage refurbishment programme at The Hurlingham Club in Fulham, south west London.

Our works here included general internal repairs and redecoration, as well repairs/replacement (timber and glass) and redecoration to window and doors.

External works included timber repairs and masonry/render repairs. We re-rendered the exterior of the east elevation with Expanded Metal Lath (EML) and lime.

We were also contracted to repair the copper on the atrium: however, on finding some of it beyond repair, we replaced a whole section. We also replaced coping stones.

Additional works included replacement of guttering and downpipes.

Finally, we painted the main house in appropriate cream paint to closely match the original colour of the 19th century mansion. The Hurlingham is an exclusive, private club which remained open during all the works: our team worked around all the major events and kept disruption for members to a minimum. We also worked through adverse winter weather conditions to keep to our schedule.

We have previously worked alongside Studio Gunn to deliver an extensive Window and Facade Renovation project for The Crown Estate at Regent's University in London.
